With the Young Lawyers Award the European Law Institute (ELI) gives voice to the next generation of legal experts. You are invited to submit your paper which deals with a European legal issue that could be improved.

Who

Applicants must be conversant in English and be students enrolled at a European university, currently undertaking a university law degree, whether undergraduate or postgraduate, or contenders who are within five years of being awarded a law degree at the date by which entries must be submitted.

How

Candidates must submit a unique and original paper which was not previously published and which deals with a European legal issue that could be improved. A jury comprised of the ELI and other institutions determines the winner. The successful candidate will be invited to present their paper at the 2019 ELI Annual Conference in Vienna (Austria). In addition to a number of prizes, Interleges will donate a EUR 500 cash prize to the winner of the award.
